

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING – SAFE RETURN PROGRAM

THIS FORM IS AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SAFE RETURN PROGRAM. BY SIGNING THIS SOU, YOU ARE AGREEING TO THE STANDARDS SET BY THIS FORM

OVERALL ACKNOWLEDGMENT

This program is completely voluntary and by signing this document you are agreeing to the standards as well as entitled to the reward system.

The reward system is as follows:

- Being the Designated Driver for a group of Marines : 3 points
- Being an on-call Designated Driver and used : 2 points
- Using a Designated Driver that is verified by the OOD : 1 points

The threshold to reach and obtain the day off is 25 points. This allows you to potentially earn a day pass every month.

Additionally, the Marine who has been a verified Designated Driver the most times in a quarter will receive an LOA.

By enrolling in this program, you are not subject to punitive action unless violations of the UCMJ are identified.

DESIGNATED DRIVER ACKNOWLEDGMENT

By choosing to enroll in this program, you accept that you will

As the Designated Driver you are expected to maintain a BAC of 0.00%.

As the Designated Driver you are taking responsibility of the Marines you are transporting.

PASSENGER ACKNOWLEDGMENT

As a Marine you are expected to ensure that all other Marines you are with conduct themselves in a safe and professional manner.

As the passenger of the Designated Driver, you are expected to listen to them as they are responsible for you.

If at anytime you become sick or damage the Designated Driver's vehicle, you will be responsible for required clean-up or repairs.

If your Designated Driver becomes unable to drive, you are expected to help coordinate in securing a safe return for all Marines you are with. This can be done by utilizing any of the following examples:

- On-call Designated Driver from the SRP
- Arrive Alive card
- Any civilian ride share program (Uber, Lyft, Etc.)
